The physical classes of Skills Training Center & New Transformed Lives projects could not run as usual. Other projects were affected by this indirectly. An active project has been Saving Life Food Assistance packages that started in 2020 and have been distributed until now.

From November to December, the situation started to return to normal. There were no restrictions on human mobility so we started to implement our projects in the city and provinces.




Children at Risk Project

9 students graduated from high school

73 children

in 24 churches were supported and received a monthly budget for rice, food, and for their school fee





We are also collaborating with local pastors to take care of the children by visiting and following up with their studies through class attendance results and their attendance at church.

Meet Chanthy. She was encouraged to drop out of school and marry at a young age. Her siblings and most girls in her village married at a young age. Yet, in 2019, when she became a part of the Children at Risk Project, she made a strong commitment to study hard and pursue a Bachelor's Degree for her mother and family.

With schools closed due to the Covid-19 pandemic, she was faced with many challenges. Yet, through the donations from the sponsor, she was able to continue studying online, having had to pay for extra phone data. Her hard work and persistence paid off with **graduating high school with a "B!"**Sadly, her mother passed away 10 days before the state exam and Chanthy was unable to share this great news with her.

Chanthy received a 30% scholarship from her grade to study at Norton University in Phnom Penh! She is pursuing a Bachelor's Degree majoring in Interior Design. She lives with her relatives and works for them part-time to have some income to support herself in the city.





New Transformed Lives Project

4 new sites were opened (7 now in total)

300 kids were supported and cared for in those sites.

600 home learning material packages were provided to those kids.

January – February taught full-time following the curriculum schedule.

March – June

online training for teachers and coordinators, teaching on administration, property care, and teacher preparation.

July – August

opened small groups and taught activities for our students. 5 to 10 students in a class.

September – present started full class activities



My name is Phy Diza, I am 11 years old, I am studying in grade 6. I live with my parents in Prey Veng Province. I've attended church and have been a Christian for 4 years now. I am also serving and helping in the worship team as a cajon player. I believe Jesus is the real God, He saved us from our sin.

Before I was not a good kid at all, I disobeyed my parents and teachers and I liked to hang out and play all day; I did not like studying. I also argued with any person or even my parents when they tried to correct or teach me not to do things.

Through the New Transformed Lives project, I want to thank God that I am now more careful with using words, helping and obeying my parents, and loving people. My behavior and attitude have changed and I have gained more knowledge from this school. My teacher and pastor have taught and helped me to understand and know how to live as a good son and love my family and neighbors; my parents are so happy to see me changed. I also have gotten better scores in my public school, because I have the opportunity to study twice for each lesson in my school project, especially the mathematics subject because now I am good at it. I am happy that I am able to study the English language in my village too.

I want to say to my teachers in the school project that I love them so much, they are nice and patient in helping me all the time. "Thank you, teacher, for teaching me!"

My name is Yoeng Thong. I'm 80 years old and I have a few health problems like Hypertension, Dehydration, Chronic Kidney Disease (CKD), Heart Disease, and Benign Prostatic Hyperplasia (BPH). These diseases can affect my life at any time. Before, I went to hospital after hospital to get good treatment in order to save my life but, I couldn't find one. One day, my son told me about a hospital and wanted to bring me there and that hospital is named Mercy Medical Center (MMC). So, my children decided to bring me there and I stayed there for around a week because I was in serious condition at that time. Yet, from day-to-day, I got healthier. I could see all the doctors, nurses, and team took care of me very well, encouraged me, and brought hope to me. Staying there around a week I was getting much better; Praise God! I'm doing well now, I just need to follow up with my doctors at MMC one time per month to keep me healthy.

My name is Tep Uddom Panha and I'm 35 years old. One day, I had a traffic accident and broke my kneecap and dislocated my ankle on the other leg; it was so painful. I was trying to find a quality, inexpensive hospital, but I couldn't find one; all of the hospitals are too expensive for me to afford. One day, I heard about Patient Care Ministry from my sister, which is a place that is connected to a lot of good, affordable hospitals. Therefore, I connected to the Ministry immediately, and very quickly they sent me to a good hospital to do surgery of my broken knee. About one week after surgery I started to feel better. I tried to walk with crutches step-by-step. My leg slowly began to heal day-by-day. I tried to exercise by walking with crutches every day. I think around 3 weeks it was really good and I could stand by myself without someone helping. Now, I can walk and do some work at home. I can walk and run around 75% and am around 95% healed in my broken knee. Thank you, Lord, and thank you, Patient Care Ministry, for helping all people who really need help like me. I would like to say thank you so much for loving and caring about me while I stayed in the Healing Home of the Patient Care Ministry. You guys did a good job for me and took care of me well in there.
